Jefferson Borden



Younger brother of Colonel Borden. Ran the Providence branch of the Fall River Iron Company. Then took over the American Print Works when Holder Borden, his nephew, died. Later became the patriarch of the Borden clan on the death of his older brother, Colonel Richard Borden, in 1874. Because of his involvement with the Providence Tool Company, Jeffereson Borden was forced to declare bankrupcy in 1878.
